Report: Israel bombed arms convoy in Sudan

During the recent Gaza war, Israeli aircraft conducted a daring mission into the heart of Africa to deny Hamas terrorists a resupply of weapons, according to a report by CBS News on Wednesday.

Citing unidentified American intelligence sources, CBS revealed that in early January, a squadron of Israeli warplanes entered Sudanese airspace and bombed a convoy of 17 trucks carrying weapons north to the Gaza Strip.

The Israelis reportedly felt the weapons had to be destroyed before reaching Egypt, in whose territory Israel would not think of conducting military operations.

Two Sudanese politicians who spoke to Reuters on Thursday confirmed the air strike, but declined to point fingers, noting that none of the witnesses of the strike were able to identify the nationality of the aircraft.

Later in the day, Sudanese State Minister for Highways Mabrouk Mubarak Saleem told Al-Jazeera that American aircraft had carried out the strike. He also insisted that the trucks were full of people, not weapons, and that over 800 civilians had been killed.

Obama Demands, Bibi Takes Notes, Campaign Intercedes

(IsraelNN.com) The Chicago-based Eretz Yisrael Committee grassroots group is petitioning the Orthodox Union (OU) to demand that U.S. President Barack Obama ease pressure on Israel to implement a two-state solution.

Committee head Yosef Rabin explains that the move is in wake of Obama’s remarks made at a press conference held Tuesday night, as well as Prime Minister-designate Binyamin Netanyahu’s statements Wednesday stating that he would continue with the “peace process.” Netanyahu announced Wednesday at the Economic Conference in Jerusalem, “The Palestinians must understand that they have in our government a partner for peace, security, and for economic development of the Palestinian economy.” The statement came a day after Obama stated his intention to drive a two-state solution upon the Netanyahu administration.

When asked how realistic he thinks it is that Israel’s new government would implement a two-state solution, [Obama responded](#), “It’s not easier than it was, but I think it’s just as necessary.” He clarified, “The status quo is unsustainable... it is critical for us to advance a two-state solution where Israelis and Palestinians can live side by side in their own states with peace and security.” The American President furthermore stated that his appointment of special envoy George Mitchell is a serious signal in “trying to move the parties in a direction that acknowledges that reality,” and that he intends to be persistent in his policy.

The statements of Netanyahu and Obama have concerned the Eretz Yisrael Committee.

“What’s news is that Netanyahu and Obama are on the same page,” Rabin says. He explains that Netanyahu is swaying away from the platform promised to his constituents to revamp the ‘peace process.’ “When Netanyahu gave his acceptance speech, he says how he chose the right-wing,” Rabin stated.

Freedom Tower Name Change Slammed as Unpatriotic

NEW YORK — Even without the name, the symbolism of the Freedom Tower as an American response to the Sept. 11 terror attacks was hard to miss.

The original architect designed a twisting form he wanted to imitate the Statue of Liberty, with a spire that rose to the deliberate height of 1,776 feet to recognize the year of American independence. Politicians called the tower proof of the country's triumph over terrorism. Former Gov. George Pataki said visitors to the iconic skyscraper "will know our determination to overcome evil" in a 2003 speech that first gave the Freedom Tower its name.

The tower – still under construction with a projected completion date of 2013 – no longer has the same architect, design or footprint on the 16-acre site. And this week, the owners of ground zero publicly parted ways with the Freedom Tower name, saying it would be more practical to market the tallest building in New York as the former north tower's name, One World Trade Center.

Posse Comitatus on the Ropes: Northcom Responds to North Dakota Flooding

The [Colorado Springs Gazette](#) reports:

Northern Command is providing help in the disaster response to flooding in North Dakota, the command said Thursday in a press release.

The command will stage at the Grand Forks Air Force Base to aid the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

NorthCom will help distribute supplies and coordinate the relief effort.

A defense coordinating officer dispatched by NorthCom will act as the liaison between FEMA and NorthCom, relaying capabilities available to FEMA and coordinating movement of active-duty personnel and equipment to assist should the need arise.

NorthCom is based at Peterson Air Force Base.

Apparently sending the military out in response to natural disasters is so common place now the corporate media does not bother to report on it.

Section 1076 of the John Warner Defense Appropriation Act essentially nullified Posse Comitatus, as Sen. Patrick Leahy argued at the time. The bill states the armed forces will be used to: "Restore public order and enforce the laws of the United States when, as a result of a natural disaster, epidemic, or other serious public health emergency, terrorist attack or incident, or other condition in any State or possession of the United States."

The the John Warner Defense Appropriation Act was subsequently repealed in its entirety. However, you wouldn't know it if you live in North Dakota.

Predator drone fighting the Red River flood

The flood fighters in the Red River have added a high-tech weapon to their arsenal this year. A Predator unmanned drone aircraft, on loan from the Department of Homeland Security, is being used to survey the valley for the first time and give officials a quicker assessment than ever before of the flood's effects on the ground.

"We think it will help the emergency management folks pinpoint the areas they have to pay the most attention to," said Juan Munoz-Torres, a spokesman for the department.
